YOUNG people are declared to be the pillar of Nepal as they can build the country in proper and systematic ways.

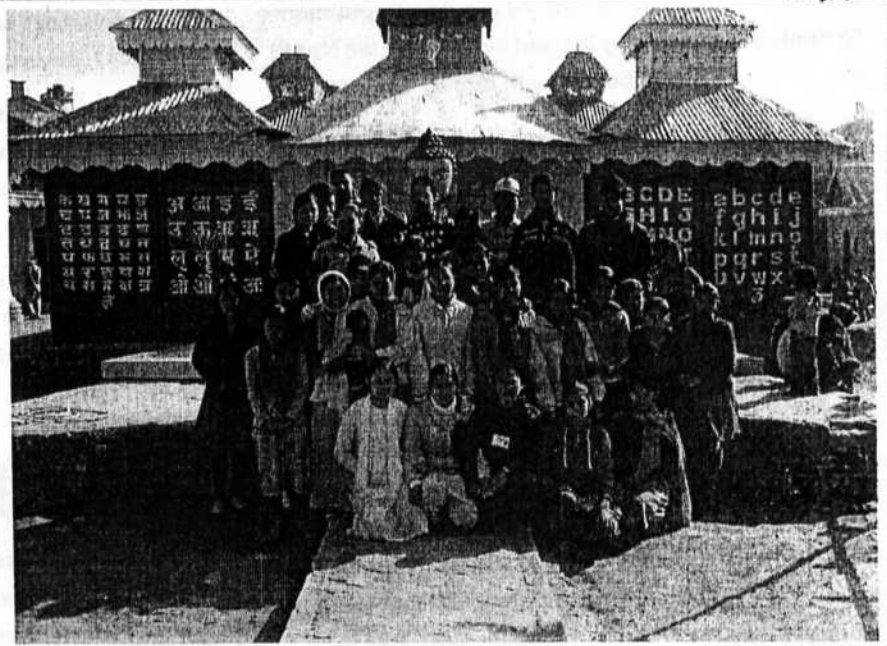
But the youth of our country is not getting the proper facilities to build themselves. They have to go far from their homes to complete their study, as there are no more universities.
